2025 HIGHLIGHTS



FOOD CLUB

We held 50 sessions on a Wednesday, and have been able to support over 3,500 Merstham residents and prevented over 7,530kg of food going to waste.

COMMUNITY FRIDGE

Our volunteers collected over 21,000kg of food, redistributed to the Merstham community.

The Food bank supported approximately 1,250 families and individuals.



SESSIONS HELD AT THE MCFT HUB

CHATTY TABLE: 49 free drop-in sessions held every Monday, leading to over 250 chats.

CITIZENS ADVICE:

Approximately 575 people attended and have spoken to an advisor.

I.T. SUPPORT: Over 70 people have been assisted.

REPAIR CAFÉ: A range of items have been repaired and fixed to the value of approximately £900, giving them a new lease of life.



WARM WELCOME

Working with the Surrey County Council, over 3,330 people attended. Advice workshops were held for keeping warm over the winter period.



HEALTH & WELLBEING

Many activities were held including Smoking Cessation, Pain Clinic, Prostate Advice, Wellbeing Walks, Pit Stop, Wildlife Walks, Community Allotment, Bee Project, Merstham Movies, Craft Activities, Covid Vaccines, Advice, Information & Signposting, Starting Point, and Young People's Counselling.
